<b>Clinical Psychology Services</b>	Children with developmental delays, ADHD, ASD, or anxiety; parents seeking clarity on their child's challenges.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Diagnosis of developmental, behavioral or emotional disorders</li> <li>Provides tailored intervention plans.</li> </ul>	<b>Yes</b>
<b>Physical Therapy</b>	Children with physical disabilities or motor function challenges.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Targeted exercises based on goals</li> <li>Teaches on the usages of assistive devices and navigate obstacles</li> </ul>	<b>NO</b>
